The advantages of this method for you and your students

- ✓ The quality and difficulty of the questions students formulate give the teacher an opportunity to assess students' comprehension.
- ✓ Students' critical thinking can be enhanced by discussing the questions they have prepared.
- ✓ This information can be used to review materials or update teaching methods.
- ✓ This method may help improve students' analytical skills.
- ✓ Students enjoy the challenge of thinking about test questions.
- ✓ Students feel proud when they see their questions in the test.
- ✓ Students appreciate the teacher's effort as they often find it more difficult than they imagined.

An effective way to review the course with your students



- Ask each student to prepare 3-4 suggested questions for the course test. Assign a space in the blackboard system for students to share these questions with their colleagues.
- Remind your students that the level of questions should not be at the level of remembering only, but also include understanding and higher thinking skills such as application and analysis.
- During the lecture, discussed with the students the connection between the questions and the learning outcomes in the course, and the level of the questions, then choose some questions to discuss their answers.
- The appropriate questions can be used to be in the test after ensuring their quality and phrasing.
