

Engaging Students in Learning with Padlet

Padlet is a digital “wall” space that supports class discussions and activities. It could engage all students in generating, integrating and reviewing ideas in one place.



Ideas for teaching with Padlet



Brainstorming- Create a Padlet and pose a question to prompt students to generate ideas or provide answers. Encourage them to engage with their classmates’ responses by liking, voting, commenting, color-coding or rearranging.

Students' Feedback- Create a Padlet with columns for reflective questions such as: What went well? and What did you learn from this lecture? Encourage students to provide answers and ideas, and to engage with their classmates’ responses.

Group discussion- Create a Padlet with columns and assign each column a topic or group name (e.g., Group orG , \ up 2). Encourage students to share their work in the designated columns; ensuring that posts are instantly visible and open for interaction by all.
