Why Do We Use Podcasts?

- A non traditional method of learning
- Usable anytime and on the go
- Promoting self-regulated learning
- Motivating students to
- learn Free of charge

Course Activities

- Select a specific podcast that aligns with course activities, allowing students to listen to it in advance and then engage in a discussion in the discussion board, answer a set of questions, or write a summary.

Enrichment Resources

- Recommend podcasts for students to refer to for further information on the course topics, provide a link to it on Blackboard, and encourage students to suggest podcasts that are relevant to the course topics.

Flipped Classroom

- Can be utilized to enhance educational content when preparing for flipped classroom sessions. Students should listen to the podcast prior to the lecture.
